

New Widgets For Creating Charts From Stratum Data in Stratum Dashboards

Incorporate new types of eye-catching visuals into Stratum Dashboards with a new collection of chart widgets and related features. More Details About Stratum Dashboards Chart Updates

The redesigned Stratum Views Pane makes fast work of adding charts to any Stratum Dashboard. Simply select a chart type as your starting point and then choose the Stratum view that will provide data for the chart. Your charts can be customized to meet your exact needs.

Note: The Stratum Views Pane and other editing features are available when an administrator is editing a dashboard.





Chart editing properties are simple to access from icons in each dashboard widget's toolbar. Open up the Chart Editor to see many options for fine-tuning the chart type and format (legends, colors, fonts, and so on). Preview areas in editing windows let you immediately see the impact of the customization process.



Additional Updates for Stratum Dashboards Users


Silvon also made a few general improvements to Stratum Dashboards. One of those updates lets you easily toggle back and forth between content in dashboards, such as a chart and its related source data. Open Stratum views for a dashboard widget in a new tab while the applicable dashboard remains visible in the original browser tab.



Dashboard administrators can use that "New Tab" feature to edit views and dashboards at the same time – for example, edit a view that feeds data into a dashboard chart then refresh the chart to reflect the latest version of the view. A new "Refresh" option is provided for that purpose when administrators are editing dashboards.



For overall ease of access, there's a shortcut for opening Stratum Dashboards directly from Stratum. The shortcut is available from a menu in the main Stratum toolbar, shown below.



Silvon Adopts an Azure Active Directory Approach for Hosted Stratum Customers

Silvon's latest version of Stratum Cloud, our hosted product offering, is fully integrated with the Microsoft Identity platform and Azure Active Directory enterprise identity services. This integration provides the following benefits:

- 1. Single-sign-on access across multiple applications and add-ins. Users can access Stratum and the Stratum Excel Connector add-in using the same Microsoft Identity they use to access Microsoft 365 and / or Azure AD. There's less User ID's and passwords to manage.
- 2. Options to take advantage of multi-factor authentication (MFA) features when accessing Stratum.
- 3. An additional layer of security derived from the use of an Azure AD Application Proxy to access Stratum. All Stratum application and Add-In access is handled by a Stratum Application Proxy dedicated to your implementation.




New Email Notifications to Keep Broadcast Manager Admins Informed

Use new Stratum Access Hub (Broadcast Manager) settings to automatically notify administrators or other interested parties about what's happening with Broadcast Manager processes. If you create and manage actions, broadcast groups, and broadcast schedules for your business analyst community, then this email notification feature is for you. The new option affords greater visibility into what's happening with the Broadcast Manager.

Designate who needs to be informed about these processes. They'll receive simple emails that tell them if a process has completed or failed. Additionally, process logs can be attached to the emails to give administrators more detailed information about each Broadcast Manager process.

The "Go To Stratum" Power BI extension to link reports in Power BI directly to more detailed data in Stratum Views.
7.2 Dec. 2020	What's New PDF – Master Data Augmentation and User Controlled Attribute functionality to supplement existing core Stratum data. More grid formatting options to enhance the style of reports. Administrators can control attribute availability in views and which display by default when their levels get used in views. Level filtering has a choice to include or exclude the designated filter set – see only the designated members or see all members except the designated ones. Shortcuts to edit captions, format string, and fill color when editing measure items from the Measures window. The process for copying view URL's to share has been streamlined.
7.1.2 Aug 2020	 What's New PDF – More tools to control and access Stratum data. See below. Shortcuts for setting up calculated measure item captions, options to control detail for emailed views and Excel exports and the order of views attached to Actions, and ability to track who is actively using Stratum. More icon choices for Conditional Formats and custom logos to help distinguish between multiple Stratum environments. Data Import – Bring budgets, market trends, plans, and other outside data that compliments enterprise data into the Stratum Data Hub from user-curated Excel spreadsheets. Immediately see imported data in Stratum for centralized analysis with the rest of your business data. Watch Video. StratumLink – A web-based ETL for Stratum power users to pull high volumes of additional core business data into the hub from complex data sources (ERP, CRM, custom databases, IoT systems, cloud sources).
