Getting Started

Access To Master Data Import

Security and view administrators have full access to Master Data Import functionality. Administrators have access to this functionality from a Master Data Import option in the Analyst Tools menu off of the main menu in Stratum.

Advanced and casual users can access some Master Data Import features if administrators give them direct access to the Master Data Import window – and in that case, they can only work with their own master data imports. The Master Data Import option will not display in the Analyst Tools menu for advanced and casual users, but there are two options for giving access to those types of users. Administrators can set up a global user link that points to the Data Import window and add it to the view groups of the applicable advanced or casual users who need access to Data Import. Or, administrators can send those users a direct URL to the Master Data Import window.

Note: Master Data Import functionality requires a Stratum Analyst Hub license and is available only for Stratum.Viewer implementations where Stratum.Server is running on a Windows server. It is not available for implementations running Stratum.Server on an IBM i Server.

Access To User Controlled Attribute Maintenance

Security and view administrators have full access to User Controlled Attributes functionality. Administrators have access to this functionality from a User Controlled Attribute option in the Manage Things menu off of the main menu in Stratum.

Note: User Controlled Attributes functionality is available only for Stratum.Viewer implementations where Stratum.Server is running on a Windows server. It is not available for implementations running Stratum.Server on an IBM i Server.

Introduction To User Controlled Attributes & Master Data Import

User Controlled Attributes gives you the ability to define and populate master data that supplements existing core Stratum data. Add new attributes on-demand that can be used to describe Stratum dimensions and support new levels of data summarization – as done in the example below. A new attribute for the UPC Global Number dimension had a hierarchy created for it, which is then used in the rows of a YTD sales report. Master Data Import is used to update those attributes with current data and is a quick way to add new dimension key values into the Stratum Data Hub. Security built into the Data Hub maintains the integrity of attributes originating from corporate business systems while keeping track of the separate incoming streams of data for User Controlled Attributes.

Here's what can you do with User Controlled Attributes:

- Add Attributes To Compliment Corporate Data Attributes provide additional descriptive details about your dimensions. Examples are Marketing Promotions and Product Groupings that are controlled and managed outside of your corporate systems.
- Import Master Data Anytime Update or replace data for User Controlled Attributes. In seconds, import master data from Excel spreadsheets. Do so without IT assistance and without waiting for the next scheduled database update.
- Define New Data Summarizations Group data into new analytical categories by creating virtual hierarchies from User Controlled Attributes. This makes the attribute available as a level to use in rows / columns of Viewer reports. See data summarized by attributes via their virtual levels. Use them the same as all other Stratum levels. Drill, filter, build calculations, and more. Master data imported for attributes will

populate their virtual hierarchies. For example, create a Customer Parent roll-up for Customer Sold-To's as an avenue for swiftly linking like customers together.

• Add New Dimension Key Values – Master Data Import functionality enhances Budget and Forecasting tasks. Add new key values for items you need to plan on that do not exist yet in corporate business systems. Is there a new Product under development that you need to account for in next year's plan? Include rows with dimension key values in the Excel file for a Master Data Import. The import adds the new key values to Stratum. Then use Viewer's Planning or Data Import to populate the items with budget / forecast measure data.

Master Data Import Requirements Checklist

A Stratum implementation that uses Master Data Import must meet the following server and software requirements. With these conditions met, administrators can finalize the setup of Master Data Import in Stratum Viewer – see the topic <u>Master Data Import Initial Setup Checklist</u>. Then, Master Data Imports can be added and processed by users.

- 1. The Stratum.Server application for the implementation must be on a Windows SQL server. Master Data Import is not available for implementations running Stratum.Server on an IBM i Server.
- 2. Stratum.Connector and Stratum.Viewer must be upgraded to version 7.4 or greater. If they are not, obtain the necessary software and upgrade as you have in the past using the separate install/upgrade guide for instructions.
- The Stratum.Viewer implementation must have a valid license for the Stratum Analyst Hub. If you don't have the Stratum Analyst Hub, contact your Silvon Sales Representative at (800) 874-5866 or email us at <u>info@silvon.com</u>. A registration key for a valid license must be specified in the Customer Info and Keys section of the Viewer <u>System Configuration window</u>.

Master Data Import Initial Setup Checklist

Here's a few things administrators need to do in Stratum.Viewer and Stratum.Connector to prepare Master Data Import functionality for users. After this setup has been completed, users can access Master Data Import features in Stratum.Viewer to add and process their master data imports.

1. Stratum.Viewer System Configuration Settings -

- Verify a registration key is specified in the Stratum Analyst Hub key section of the <u>System Configuration</u> <u>window</u>. Master Data Import is part of the Stratum Analyst Hub.
- Specify an upload file location for Master Data Imports using the provided field in the Process Options section of the System Configuration window. Copies of import data files are stored in that location. Import files are your Microsoft Excel files that contain imported data. See <u>Specify Upload Location</u>.

2. Stratum.Connector Parameter Settings -

- Review The "Process Pending User Controlled Attribute Update" Settings Properties in that section of the General tab in Connector's Parameter Settings window determine how pending changes for User Controlled Attributes added or edited in Stratum.Viewer are treated by Limited and Standard processes. Setting a process type to No means it won't process any pending changes. Setting a process type to Yes means pending changes will be processed. The process will check for pending changes then switch to a Full process if changes are found so all changes can be processed. See <u>Connector help</u> for complete details.
- Review The "User Controlled Attribute Update Notification" Settings Properties in that section of the Email tab in Connector's Parameter Settings window control the email that's sent when a Stratum.Viewer user has added, made changes to, or deleted a User Controlled Attribute. The email tells the recipient that a Full process may be required in Connector to process the change.

- 3. **Stratum.Connector's Consolidation Writeback Process ---** If you are using Master Data Import and the Planning application to update the Stratum warehouse, make sure that your custom Consolidation Writeback process for Stratum Connector runs the LOADOLAP and CRTOMAST commands.
 - Master Data Import allows users to import data for dimension key values that don't exist in a Mast table.
 When a key value does not exist, then a key value will be added to the UCA Master and MembersN tables.

Note: The dimension key value is NOT added to the MASTER and MAST tables.

- Once the dimension key value is added using Master Data Import, users can add planning data for that key value. This means that there will be transactions in the Planning Writeback tables for key values that don't exist in the Mast table.
- The custom Consolidation Writeback process for Connector needs to run the LOADOLAP and CRTOMAST commands so that any new dimension key values will be properly added to the Mast table.

Tasks – Setting Up User Controlled Attributes

Add A User Controlled Attribute To Stratum

- 1. Click Manage Things then User Controlled Attribute from the main menu in the top panel of Stratum.
- 2. In the User Controlled Attribute list window, click New User Controlled Attribute
- 3. Set up the properties for the new attribute in the User Controlled Attribute Maintenance window.
 - **Dimension** Choose the dimension to which you want the attribute added.
 - Attribute Enter a name for the attribute.
 - **Default Value** Specify a character(s) to display as the default value for the attribute. That value will be used for key values that do not yet have data for the attribute. When you see the default value for an attribute in a view, that indicates data does not currently exist for the attribute. For example, if you have not imported data for the attribute using Master Data Import functionality, all key values will be set to the default value. This property defaults to "?" but you can customize it to any text you prefer to use, up to 50 characters.
 - **Create Hierarchy?** Optionally create a hierarchy based on the new attribute. Creating a hierarchy for it lets you see your data summarized by that attribute by making the attribute available as a level that can be included in rows / columns of a view. "Yes" will create it and enable the name fields below it. You can customize the name of the hierarchy and the level that gets created for it. Names must be different than the attribute on which they are based. The hierarchy and level name default to the name of the dimension for the attribute followed by the name given to the attribute. "No" will skip creating the hierarchy.
- 4. Save required properties for the new attribute. You are returned to the list window where the addition shows with a Pending Updates status of Yes. The attribute will be added and available in Stratum.Viewer *after* the next Full process occurs in Stratum.Connector. Contact your Stratum administrator for information about when the next Full process is scheduled.

Create A Hierarchy Based On A User Controlled Attribute

Creating a hierarchy for an attribute lets you see your data summarized by that attribute by making the attribute available as a level that can be included in rows / columns of a view. Data imported into the attribute will populate the hierarchy/level created off the attribute. Use the new level in rows or columns of a view as you would any other level.

- 1. Click Manage Things then User Controlled Attribute from the main menu in the top panel of Stratum.
- 2. In the User Controlled Attribute list window, select the attribute you previously added and click Edit .
- 3. Select "Yes" for Create Hierarchy property when the attribute opens in the <u>User Controlled Attribute</u> <u>Maintenance window</u>.
- 4. Enter a name for the hierarchy and its level. The names must be different than the attribute on which they are based.
- 5. Save **I** the changes. You are returned to the list window where the change shows with a Pending Updates status of Yes. The hierarchy and level will be added and available in Stratum.Viewer *after* the next Full process occurs in Stratum.Connector. Contact your Stratum administrator for information about when the next Full process is scheduled

Note: Steps above show how to edit an attribute you already added to create a hierarchy from it. You also can create the hierarchy when first adding the attribute. See <u>Add A User Controlled Attribute To Stratum</u>.

Process Pending User Controlled Attribute Additions/Changes (Uses Stratum.Connector)

Adding or changing a User Controlled Attribute is done in Stratum.Viewer. Those additions and changes won't be reflected in Stratum.Viewer until a Full process has been done by Stratum.Connector. A Full process can be scheduled to occur on a regular basis, done in batch, or kicked off manually in Stratum.Connector. Emails configured in Stratum.Connector notify your administrator when Viewer users add or change a User Controlled Attribute. The emails tell the recipients that there are pending changes to process. The timing of when a Full process happens should be done when it won't impact the use of Viewer. Users will not have access to views or most administrator features in Viewer during a Full Process.

See the Connector help for details about parameters and processes managed in that application.

Note: See also Master Data Import Initial Setup Checklist.

Tasks – Importing Master Data For User Controlled Attributes

Specify Upload File Location For Master Data Imports

- 1. Click Manage Things then System Configuration from the main menu in the top panel of Stratum.
- 2. Scroll to the Data Imports properties in the Process Options section of the System Configuration window.
- 3. Use the Master Data Import Upload File Location property to specify the path for the folder that will be used by Master Data Imports. The Master Data Import location is used when importing values into User Controlled Attributes.

- When specifying the location, use the full UNC path format \\host-name\share-name\file_path\ and include a backslash mark \ as the final character. For example: \\serverabc\User Controlled Data\Uploaded Import Files\
- The location must be one that exists already and one to which your implementation's Viewer Impersonation account has access rights.
- 4. Save 🔚 the changes.

Import Master Data For User Controlled Attributes

- 1. Click Analyst Tools then Master Data Import from the main menu in the top panel of Stratum.
- 2. In the Master Data Import list window, click New
- 3. When prompted, choose the Excel file to import. Then click Open.
- 4. Use the <u>Import Configuration window</u> to select the Target dimension for the import and make other selections that tell Master Data Import about data in the file. The Target dimension has the User Controlled Attributes where imported data is meant to be added, and the selection impacts the attributes available during Step 5.

Note: Once you have done a few imports, Master Data Import learns about your import data habits and can do some automatic configuration and Data Mapping. When that happens, the Import Configuration window is bypassed. You can open it anytime by clicking the Configuration button in the Data Mapping window.

- Import Option Choose Update or Replace. An Update will update existing data and add any new data included in the import file. A Replace clears existing data for **all** of the User Controlled Attributes that belong to the import's Target dimension then adds data from the import file to the applicable attributes. Care should be taken when using a Replace since it removes data for **all** of a dimension's User Controlled Attributes even if the attributes aren't included in the import file. If there is existing data you don't want to lose, then set the import configuration to Update instead of Replace. See also When To Do An Update Vs. When To Do A Replace For Your Master Data Imports.
- **Target Dimension** The Target dimension is the one with the attribute(s) that will receive imported data. User Controlled Attributes from that dimension will be available to select when you map imported data to Stratum.
- Header Rows In File Specify how many header rows are in the import file. Header rows contain descriptive details that aid you in mapping but do not get imported. For example, the row(s) contain dimension names, descriptions, or attribute names.
- 5. Use the <u>Data Mapping window</u> to finish telling Stratum what dimensions and attribute data are in the import file. Drop-down lists are provided at the top of the data preview. Use them to make mapping selections.
 - **Ignore** For any columns you don't want considered, select Ignore.
 - **Dimension** Choose Dimension for the column that contains the dimension key values, then use the Select A Target drop-down list to select the name of the Target dimension for the data.
 - **Attribute** Choose Attribute for columns that contain attribute data (values), then use the Select A Target drop-down list to select the name of the Target attribute for the data.
- 6. Click the Validate button to check that import data is in the proper format and contains the needed details to proceed.
- 7. Master Data Imports are meant to be processed after you are done mapping their data to Stratum. Click the

Submit The Master Data Import For Processing icon. When prompted, confirm that you want to proceed with the process.

Adjust Data Mapping And Import Configuration For Master Data Import

You can edit an import's mapping and other configuration details at any time while previewing the data.

Configuration

To adjust general import properties like the Target dimension, click the Configuration button. Use the Import Configuration window to make changes, then click OK.

- Import Option Choose Update or Replace. An Update will update existing data and add any new data included in the import file. A Replace clears existing data for all of the User Controlled Attributes that belong to the import's Target dimension then adds data from the import file to the applicable attributes. Care should be taken when using a Replace since it removes data for all of a dimension's User Controlled Attributes even if the attributes aren't included in the import file. If there is existing data you don't want to lose, then set the import configuration to Update instead of Replace. See also When To Do An Update Vs. When To Do A Replace For Your Master Data Imports.
- **Target Dimension** The Target dimension is the one with the attribute(s) that will receive imported data. User Controlled Attributes from that dimension will be available to select when you map imported data to Stratum.
- Header Rows In File Specify how many header rows are in the import file. Header rows contain descriptive details that aid you in mapping but do not get imported. For example, the rows contain dimension names, descriptions, or attribute names.

Mapping

Use the provided drop-down selection lists in the preview to adjust mapping for each column in the import.

- Ignore For any columns you don't want considered, select Ignore.
- **Dimension** Choose Dimension for column that contains the dimension key values, then use the Select A Target drop-down list to select the name of the Target dimension for the data.
- Attribute Choose Attribute for columns that contain attribute data (values), then use the Select A Target drop-down list to select the name of the Target attribute for the data.

Delete a Master Data Import

- 1. Click Analyst Tools then Master Data Import from the main menu in the top panel of Stratum.
- 2. In the Master Data Import list window, select the Master Data Import you need to delete.
- Click Delete .
- 4. Click Yes in the prompt that displays to proceed with the deletion.

They help identity what is in each column – saving you time as you map columns or mark them to be ignored while setting up your import. The example shown in the next image uses one header row. You can use more than one header row if needed. All header rows must be located at the top of your file, above the rows of import data.

Avoid Null Rows (They're Treated As The End of an Import)

Make sure you don't have a null row interspersed with rows of data in your import file. A Null row is a row without any data (note that a cell with all blank spaces or with zeroes in it is not considered null). The first null row that Master Data Import encounters in an import file will be treated as the end of your file. Master Data Import stops looking for data to import once it finds a null row. In this example, you'd want to remove row 14. If you don't, the import will stop at that row and not consider any of the rows of data after that point.

Exclude Unnecessary Extras

Certain types of information should be excluded either because they don't make sense for an import, aren't necessary for an import, could disrupt the upload process*, or could throw off the integrity of the import such as bring in unwanted data.

- Exclude measure values, grand totals, and subtotals. Only include dimension and master data in import files.
- Delete any hidden rows from the Excel file, otherwise they will show up in the data import preview and be included in the data that gets imported. If you don't want data from hidden rows, delete the rows from the Excel file before you import it.
- Delete hidden columns from the Excel file, otherwise they will show up in the data import preview. If you don't want data from hidden columns included in your import, delete the columns from the Excel file before you import it OR mark the columns as Ignore when mapping the data.
- In cases where you use an exported Stratum.Viewer view as the starting point when creating an import file, it is recommended that you disable or **exclude the following Viewer features before exporting the view**.
 - o "All Others" rows or columns related to filtering.
 - Conditional format icons or formatting.
 - o Charts.
 - o Hyperlinks.
 - o Calculated measure items that return images.
 - Pop-up labels on measure items.
 - o Drilldown views linked up to rows, columns, or measure items.
 - Also consider excluding specialty Excel items like the items listed below.
 - o Images.

- o Charts.
- o Cell borders.
- o Comments or notes.
- Excel features such as text boxes.

Attributes And Hierarchies Window

This window shows all attributes and hierarchies that exist for a dimension. The window is accessible when you are working with a User Controlled Attribute in the <u>User Controlled Attribute Maintenance window</u>. The attributes and hierarchies for a dimension must have unique names. This window helps you plan out names for new attributes and hierarchies by seeing the names already used for the dimension's existing ones.

Here is the initial state of the import preview. Viewer was able to map the first column to a dimension through automatic mapping. That column mapped to the Type of Dimension and a Target dimension of Customer Priority. All other columns defaulted to Ignore. Also, Master Data Import assumed that the import file had one header row, which is the row displayed with a green background.

Processing logs can be attached to these emails to provide more detailed information about a process. For hosted environments, Silvon has validations in place to prevent processing logs from being attached to system-generated emails if a recipient's email isn't associated with Silvon's hosted domain for Stratum Cloud. This protects sensitive information from being shared with non-administrators or outside email addresses. For example, logs would only be sent to emails from @silvoncloud.com or @silvon.com.

Connection Pool Properties - Connection pools for Stratum.Viewer are managed via Stratum.Viewer rather than via Microsoft Analysis Services. To support this connection pooling, two parameters are available. The settings determine how many connection pool connections can exist for each user's role and how long idle connections can be left open before Stratum.Viewer closes them.

Review Processing Details For A Master Data Import

The Processing report provides detailed summaries of a Master Data Import. The report is an Excel file containing all details about an import, such as the <u>Target dimension</u> for the import and the User Controlled Attributes to which data was imported. The report also indicates the status of the different stages of processing for an import. To open a report:

- 1. Click Analyst Tools then Master Data Import from the main menu in the top panel of Stratum.
- 2. In the <u>Master Data Import list window</u>, select the applicable import then click See Processing Details For A

Master Data Import

Here's an example report. The start of it shows general details like the name of the import file, who created and submitted the import for processing, and when processing was completed. Next are Import Configuration details that show selections made in that window. The next section, which contains Processing Details, show the names of database tables involved in the import then the names and status details for each processing stage.

Understanding Your Imported Master Data

The following information helps you understand what data will display in views for the User Controlled Attributes that you create and for any hierarchies created from those attributes.

• Default Values Show For User Controlled Attributes Until You Import Master Data – The default value assigned to a User Controlled Attribute at the time you created it will display for all of its members that do not yet have master data. As you begin importing master data for them, the default value members will be replaced with your imported data. In the following example, the User Controlled CPrnt Shipping Status attribute has had master data imported for some but not all of its members. The default value assigned to the attribute was a question mark ?. The five members displaying that mark are ones for which master data has not been imported yet.

• Imported Values Are Used As Hierarchy Members For Hierarchies Created From User Controlled Attributes – You have the option to create a hierarchy from an User Controlled Attribute. This lets you see your data summarized by that attribute by making the attribute available as a level that can be included in rows / columns of a view. The master data you import for a User Controlled Attribute also is used to populate the members of its hierarchy/level if you opted to create a hierarchy from that attribute. In this example, the first level on rows is from a hierarchy that was created from a User Controlled Attribute. The values a user imported for the attribute are what became the members for that hierarchy's level.

The Shipping Status attribute in the prior example had a hierarchy created from it. The first image that follows shows the related properties for that hierarchy and its level in the User Controlled Attribute Maintenance window. Using Master Data Import To Add New Dimension Key Values

Master Data Imports are primarily used to import data in User Controlled Attributes, whose set up is controlled through Stratum. Viewer's Used Controlled Attribute Maintenance. Another way you can use Master Data Import functionality is to add new dimension key values to Stratum. Doing that is useful during Budget or Forecasting activities when a new customer or product you need to budget / forecast for doesn't exist yet in your Corporate business system. For example, there's a new Customer Account that'll be activated soon or there's a new Product under development – and you want to account for them in Next Year's plan that you are setting up. You can include a row(s) with a key value for the dimension's new item(s) in a Master Data Import file. The import will add the new key values to Stratum for you, and then you can use Planning or Data Import functionality in Viewer to add budget / forecast data to the new items.

The following example shows a case for the UPC Global Number dimension. The user wants to add a couple User Controlled Attributes for the dimension and wants to add a new UPC Global Number to use while drafting next year's working plan. The view they'll use for planning is shown below before anything was added. The attributes get added with User Controlled Maintenance. Then, a Master Data Import is used to add data for the new attributes and add the key value for the new UPC Global Number.

When To Do An Update Vs. When To Do A Replace For Your Master Data Imports

There are two ways to configure your Master Data Imports. They can be set up to do an Update or a Replace, and the choice impacts the treatment of existing data. More information and examples follow to help you decide what type of import to use.

An **Update** is the more common type of import. It's the default configuration for Master Data Imports. An Update will update existing data and add any new data included in the import file.

A **Replace** is the less commonly used type of import. It clears existing data for **all** of the User Controlled Attributes that belong to the import's Target dimension then adds data from the import file to the applicable attributes.

- When might you need to do a Replace? You want to start over with a clean slate for a dimension. For
 example, you've done multiple imports for a dimension and want to start over with a fresh set of data or you
 mistakenly added new key values to the dimension and aren't using them.* A replace deletes all data for all
 of the dimension's User Controlled Attributes and removes any unused dimension key values added by
 past Master Data Imports unused key values are those that don't have any measure data. Key values
 that have measure data won't be removed by a Replace.
- Care should be taken when using a Replace since it removes data for **all** of a dimension's User Controlled Attributes. If there is existing data you don't want to lose, then set the import configuration to Update instead of Replace.
- Make sure the import file you use for the Replace includes all User Controlled Attributes for all key values you want updated for the dimension.

*Note: To avoid adding new key values you don't need, make sure your import file only includes rows for the desired key values you want to update. See also the topic <u>'What Does "Import File Contains Key Values That Don't Currently Exist In Stratum" Message Mean?</u>'.

The following examples show an Update and a Replace to illustrate cases when you might choose to use each type of import.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's)

Can I Import Data Into More Than One Attribute At A Time?

Yes, if the User Controlled Attributes belong to the same dimension. Your import file can handle importing data for more than one attribute for the same dimension. In the following example, data is being imported into three attributes for the UPC Global Number dimension.

Can I Import Data Into Corporate Controlled Attributes?

No. Data for Corporate Controlled Attributes always originates from your Corporate business systems and is stored in your Stratum.Server database.

Is There A Limit To How Many User Controlled Attributes I Can Set Up?

Yes. You can add a maximum of 99 User Controlled Attributes per dimension.

What Does "Import File Contains Key Values That Don't Currently Exist In Stratum" Message Mean?

If your import file includes dimension key values that don't currently exist in Stratum, you will get the following message. It tells you "Your import file contains key value(s) that don't currently exist in Stratum". Key values are unique identifiers of the members belonging to your Stratum dimensions.

• If you **did not** intend to add new key values for the dimension, then you need to cancel this import, remove rows containing the values from your import file, and try again. To cancel the import, click OK in this

message and then click Exit V in the mapping window, which returns you to the Master Data Import list window. Nothing will be saved or processed for the import you were setting up

 If you did intend to add the new key value, then click OK and proceed with your import. See also <u>Using</u> <u>Master Data Import To Add New Dimension Key Values</u>. That topic shows an example of an import where new key values were included to aid in business planning activities.

Here's an example where a user didn't intend to include a new key value. The dimension Product Group has four members 10, 11, 12, and 13. The user set up some User Controlled Attributes for the dimension and wants to import some data for them using the following import file. The last row was intended to be for existing key value 13, but there is a typo which makes the value there 133. Master Data Import will treat that value as a new key value. The user needs to correct the value to 13 and then try the import again.

What Happens If I Delete a Master Data Import That's Been Processed?

The definition for the import and its processing report will be deleted. The data that got imported when the import was processed remains in Stratum for you to use.

What Should I Do If An Import File Size Exceeds Maximum Allowed Size?

A technical message from your browser telling you "the request entity is too large" or "content length exceeds the configured value" means that the size of your import file exceeds the maximum allowed file size. Files around the 28MB size or higher may result in this type of message and stop an import file upload.

A work around for this scenario is to split up your import into multiple, smaller files each with less rows and/or columns of data. Divide the data up into smaller files and import each file separately.

Why Can't I Delete A Master Data Import?

Master Data Import definitions can only be deleted if they have a status of Completed or Error. An import that has a status of In Process cannot be deleted because Master Data Import is actively working with the import definition and import file.

Why Did I Get An Email About Pending Changes For A User Controlled Attribute?

You will receive that type of email if related Stratum email settings identify you as a recipient for that type of notification. The email is sent out when someone adds a new User Controlled Attribute or changes an existing User Controlled Attribute. The email helps tell the recipients, typically your Stratum.Connector administrators, that changes exist and a Full process may be needed to update Viewer with the changes. The last image below shows the Parameter setting window in Connector where this type of email notification is controlled. The recipients, email subject, and email body text are set up in that window.

Why Didn't I Get An Email About A Master Data Import After It Finished Processing?

A few things can influence email delivery.

- The Master Data Import may still be processing. Check its status in the <u>Master Data Import list window</u> or open its Processing Report to review processing stage details. See the topic <u>Review Processing Details For A Master</u> <u>Data Import</u>.
- 2. An email address might not be specified for your user profile in Stratum.Viewer. An administrator can check your profile and verify it has an email defined for it.
- 3. The email may have been routed to your Junk email folder instead of your Inbox.

Why Didn't The Import Configuration Window Show When I Uploaded An Import File?

Master Data Import makes configuration selections for you automatically when it picks up on and remembers selections from prior imports. Automatic configuration can save you steps in the import setup process.

You can open the import configuration window and make changes anytime from the <u>Data Mapping</u> preview by clicking Configuration.

Why Isn't A User Controlled Attribute Available In My Views?

A few things may cause a User Controlled Attribute not to show up in your views:

- The level for the attribute isn't included in the view. Verify the level has been added to the rows, columns, or view filter. You may also need to edit attribute relationship selections to select if for use in the view using the Edit Attribute Relationships window for the level.
- The attribute may have been disabled for use in administrator settings. Administrators can disable attributes from a Dimension window in Stratum.Viewer.
- The attribute is newly added and the pending updates to Viewer have not yet been processed. Additions or edits made in User Controlled Attribute Maintenance won't be reflected in Viewer until after the next Full process happens in Stratum.Connector.

Why Were Some Mapping Selections Made For Me Automatically & Can I Change Selections?

Master Data Import makes mapping selections for you automatically when it picks up on and remembers selections from prior imports. For example, if you imported into a User Controlled Attribute for the Product dimension. The next time you do an import with a file that includes that dimension, automatic mapping will set the column for that dimension to Product in the mapping preview. Automatic mapping can save you steps in the import setup process.

You can change mapping selections using controls in the top two rows of the Data Mapping preview.

Corporate Controlled Attribute

Attribute values are controlled either on the corporate side of things in Stratum.Server or using Stratum.Viewer's Master Data Import functionality. Both types can be used in the same way in Viewer. Values for Corporate Controlled Attributes originate from your Corporate business systems and are stored in your Stratum.Server database.

Regular Measure Item

Regular measure items are items based on the measures in the Analysis Services database for your Stratum.Viewer environment.

Regular measure items can be created with or without time ranges, depending on the Time Range property for a view. If the Time Range property is Yes for a view, you can specify time ranges for its measure items. If the Time Range property is No, then time range functionality is disabled, but you can use time hierarchies in the view.

The regular measure items in the following view are based on Daily Sales measures and have a time range of Week 37 through 38 of 2014.

Target Dimension For Master Data Import

Master Data Imports have data mapping properties that define where imported data belongs after the import gets processed. Data can be imported into User Controlled Attributes of the dimension that has been selected as the Target Dimension for the Master Data Import.

User Controlled Attribute

Attribute values are controlled either on the corporate side of things in Stratum.Server or using Stratum.Viewer's Master Data Import functionality. Both types can be used in the same way in Viewer. User Controlled Attributes are ones whose values originate from an Excel spreadsheet and become part of Stratum using Stratum.Viewer's Master Data Import functionality.* Use Stratum.Viewer's User Controlled Attribute Maintenance functionality to define attributes, maintain attribute properties, create or remove hierarchies based on the attributes, or delete the attributes. In Connector, you can view their properties including seeing any hierarchy created from the attribute.

***Note:** User Controlled Attribute Maintenance functionality is only available for implementations running Stratum.Server on a Windows SQL server and that have a license for the Stratum Analyst Hub. It is not available for implementations running Stratum.Server on an IBM i Server.
